Mr. Wandell,

The Department of Planning and Zoning has received the required letters of approval to the complete construction plans and specifications for <u>Almedia Gardens</u>.

Based on the letters received from the Departments of Public Works (DPW), Wastewater, and the Coastal Zone Administrator limiting their approval to Phases 1 and 2, formal construction approval is granted for those phases as shown on the updated phasing plan dated September 20, 2024.

Please provide written notification to the Departments of Public Works, Waterworks, and Planning and Zoning at least fourteen (14) days in advance of your intent to commence subdivision construction activities. Upon receipt of this notification the Department of Public Works will coordinate the scheduling of the mandatory pre-construction review meeting, where expectations for the phasing of this subdivision will be further discussed.

At the conclusion of the Pre-Construction Review meeting the Director of the Department of Public Works may issue, in writing, a formal Notice to Proceed for construction activities. In no event shall construction activities commence until such time that a formal Notice to Proceed is issued.

This approval is valid for six (6) months, and construction approval of any phase of an approved subdivision expires when construction is interrupted on any such phase for a period of six (6) months.

SUBJECT: Wetland Permit Verification

This memo certifies that Local Coastal Use Permit SCP 2019-01 (modified), was issued on March 7, 2023 to Wayne Wandell for Steway Holdings, LLC and Thomas Brown with Biological Surveys. The CUP authorizes construction of 135 lots, streets, and infrastructure for Almedia Gardens Subdivision pursuant to mitigation of 4.07 acres of impacted wetland the Louisiana coastal zone.

Phases 1 and 2 on the plat entitled "Phasing Plan of Almedia Gardens, in Almedia Plantation, Township 12 South, Range 9 East, in St. Rose, St. Charles Parish, LA" appear to contain wetland areas that have been mitigated and *134 lots* (with streets and infrastructure).

#### For that reason, Phases 1 and 2 have met the wetland permit obligation.

Please note that 7.37 acres of wetland remain unmitigated on the property. Although these acres were valued in CUP SCP 2019-01, the developer chose to mitigate only 4.07 acres to guide the development of the site.

Because of the way the developers mitigated, development activities can only be permitted within Phases 1 and 2 and the area of the 20 ft. wide utility easement that runs from Sq. E Lot 2 between Lots 48 and 49, Sq. F.
